ABOUT US

Gbenjus Foundation is a nonprofit organization committed to improving the lives of elders in Nigeria. We create a community where older persons feel valued, supported, and respected. Through visits, donations, and outreach events, we restore dignity and joy to those often forgotten.

Founded in September 2021, the foundation began with a simple but powerful goal: to care for the aged with compassion and consistency. Our very first outreach, held in December 2021 and tagged "Support An Elder," laid the foundation for what has grown into a movement of love, service, and advocacy.

Since then, Gbenjus Foundation has successfully carried out three additional outreach programs, each one deepening our commitment to serve and highlighting the pressing needs of older persons in underserved communities. We officially registered as an NGO on 18th October 2022, marking a significant step in expanding our reach and impact.

Through every initiative, we continue to shine a light on the importance of caring for the aged, because everyone deserves to age with grace, comfort, and dignity. We believe that when we honor the elderly, we honor the legacy of our society, and together, we can build a future that remembers, respects, and embraces its elders.



MISSION

At Gbenjus Foundation, our mission is to assist elders and older persons who are in need by providing them with the basic physical, emotional, and social support required to live a good and comfortable life.

We are committed to addressing the pressing challenges faced by older persons in our society; such as neglect, starvation, and loneliness, through compassionate outreach, essential care, and the creation of a supportive

community where they feel seen, heard, and valued.

VISION

To build a society where every elder person lives with dignity, care, and respect, free from neglect and isolation. We envision a future where older persons are not only provided with their basic needs but are also celebrated, heard, and fully integrated into the community. A world where aging is embraced with compassion, and every elder feels valued, safe, and supported.

- To provide care, comfort, and basic needs to the aged and elderly in underserved communities.
- To create safe spaces and support systems that reduce loneliness and social isolation among older persons.

- To organize regular outreach programs that promote health, happiness, and well-being in later life.
- To build partnerships that strengthen our capacity to serve and support the elderly effectively.

PROJECTS AND EVENTS (PAST EVENTS)

Over the years, Gbenjus Foundation has consistently championed the welfare of older persons through impactful outreach initiatives. Here's a recap of our key projects so far:

December 18, 2021 – Support An Elder (Delta State): Our maiden outreach took place in Delta State, where 150 elders received food items to support their daily needs. This marked the beginning of our mission to care for the aged.

December 2022 – Support An Elder 2.0 (Ogun, Lagos & Delta States): The second edition spanned three states: Ogun (Dec 17), Lagos (Dec 19), and Delta (Dec 23). A total of 300 elderly individuals received food items and cash support to ease their end-of-year burden.



December 2023 – Support An Elder 3.0 (Ogun, Lagos & Delta States): This edition featured free medical check-ups and the distribution of inspected medications. A total of 246 elders benefited from the outreach across the three states.

December 2024 – Support An Elder 4.0: “December to Remember” (Lagos): 80 elders were hosted to a festive end-of-year celebration in Lagos. The foundation also visited the Catholic Old People’s Home with food items and cash gifts, bringing joy and relief during the holidays.

February 2025 – Valentine’s Outreach (Mushin, Lagos): In the spirit of love, Gbenjus Foundation visited the Regina Mundi Catholic Church Elderly Home with food items and monetary gifts to honor and celebrate the residents on Valentine’s Day.

Impact Summary:

Since inception, Gbenjus Foundation has reached a total of 776 elders and 2 old people's homes across three states in Nigeria (Delta, Ogun, and Lagos).



(PROJECTS AND EVENTS (UPCOMING EVENTS))

At Gbenjus Foundation, we believe in staying intentional about our impact. The following upcoming projects reflect our continued dedication to restoring dignity, joy, and care to the elderly:

Monthly Random Act of Kindness (Starting July 2025): Beginning in the third quarter of 2025, the foundation will launch a new monthly initiative dedicated to visiting one older person each month with food items and a token of financial support. This act of love reminds us that even small gestures can make a big difference in someone's life.

Every purchase directly supports our elderly outreach programs, helping to provide care, comfort, and essential needs to older people in our community. Support An Elder 5.0 – December 2025:

As we celebrate five impactful years, Support An Elder 5.0 will be our biggest outreach yet. This milestone edition will reflect our growth, our gratitude, and our ongoing promise to never stop showing up for the aged.
